## **INTRODUCTION**

These By-Laws and Regulations have been made in accordance with the authority given to the State Committee of the Uncle Bobs Club in paragraph 52 of the Articles of Association, which reads:

The State Committee shall from time to time make, repeal and amend all By-laws and regulations not inconsistent with these Articles as it shall think expedient for the internal management and well being of the Association and may there impose reasonable fines, not exceeding \$2.00 for any breach of such By-laws and Regulations .

All By-laws and Regulations made by State Committee under these Articles shall be binding upon the members until repealed by the State Committee or set aside by a resolution of a General Meeting of the Association.

## **CHANGES TO SUBSCRIPTIONS:**

REFERENCE: the Articles of Association paragraph 3(a).

The subscription at the time of Incorporation (October, 1983) was \$5.20 per annum.

The State Committee determined at its meeting in October, 1983 that, in the event of a proposal that subscription rate be altered, the following procedures shall apply:

- (a) the proposed new subscription rate and the reasons for the change are to be advised to all members in a prominent notice in the Club's magazine.
- (b) Postal vote forms are to be published in the same magazine.
- (c) An independent returning officer is to be appointed.
- (d) The result of the vote is to be published in the next issue of the Club's magazine
- (e) The result of the vote shall be binding on all members of the Club.

## **BEQUEST CLAUSE**

As a result of a few enquiries to the Club by solicitors and other persons acting on behalf of clients who wish to bequeath money to the Club, the State Committee determined at its August 1989 meeting that the following Bequest Clause be inserted into these By-laws and regulations and that it be quoted to, or a copy of it provided to persons requiring this information.

The Bequest Clause reads:

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby bequeath the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ to the Uncle Bobs Club, situated at 4/41-43 Allied Drive Tullamarine VIC 3043, to be used in accordance with the aims of the Club as determined by the State Committee (Directors) of the Uncle Bobs Club.

## **ELIGIBILITY OF PAID STAFF FOR BRANCH/GROUP COMMITTEE:**

The following By-Law was passed by State Committee at the meeting on 28<sup>th</sup> November 1989.

'That a paid employee of the Club may be a member of a Branch or Group committee, but not in an executive capacity, i.e. President, Secretary or Treasurer.'

## **POSITIONS ON STATE COMMITTEE:**

The following By-Law was passed by State Committee at the meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> February 1990.

'That the positions of President, Treasurer and Secretary can not be held for more than 3 consecutive years, unless a special resolution is passed by the directors of the Club, inviting year by year continuance.'
