Uncle Bobs Club Annual Good Friday Barrow Push; 29th March 2024

I refer to your notification, requesting continuance of Permit No. 3365889, to conduct the Uncle Bobs Club Annual Good Friday Barrow Push ('Event') on an arterial road on Friday, 29th March 2024 between the hours of 8:30 am and 5:30 pm. The Event Period includes any time needed for set up and removal of signage under the Traffic Management Plan. No traffic management activities may take place outside the Event Period.

I advise that Permit No 3365889 under section 99B (1) of the Road Safety Act 1986 applies to the Event on the designated freeway(s) or arterial road(s), subject to compliance with the conditions of the permit and:

- compliance with the Traffic Management Plan (TMP) and Risk Management Plan (RMP) which formed part of the original permit; or
- if you have submitted a new Traffic Management Plan (TMP) to satisfy a requirement of the existing permit, compliance with the new TMP and the original RMP.

Head, Transport for Victoria authorises, for the purposes of the *Road Safety (Traffic Management) Regulations 2019*, any event signage or traffic control devices outlined in the most recent TMP.

This permit does not authorise the collection of monies during the conduct of the event. VicRoads permission is not required to conduct a Highway Collection. A Highway Collection can only be permitted by the Chief Commissioner of Police, in accordance with Regulation 32 of the Road Safety (Traffic Management) Regulations 2019.

Please note that the Head, Transport for Victoria reserves the right to revoke your permit in respect of any or all events without warning and at no cost to it in the event of any emergency listed in the permit, or declared by the State or Federal government, including a pandemic. It would be advisable to consult government websites and health advisories about any such emergency, including information provided by the Department of Health.

Please ensure that you contact the Victorian Traffic Management Centre on tel. 1300 107 757 (all hours) immediately before the commencement and at the completion of each Event, quoting the name of the Event and the relevant reference number (RWE).

The reference number for the 2024 Event is: RWE No. 231398.


This document now forms part of Permit No. 3365889 and must be able to be produced, together with that Permit, at the event location on the request of any member of Victoria Police or any person who is an authorised officer under Section 71 of the Road Management Act 2004.
